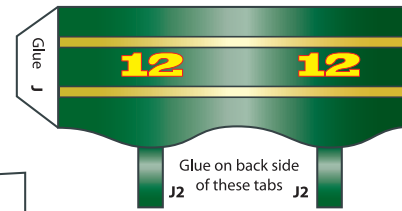

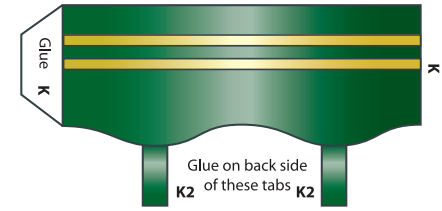

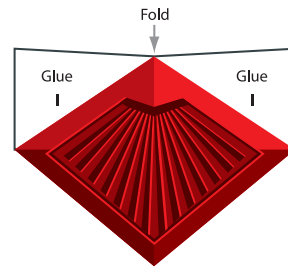
Locomotive #12 is the last surviving narrow-gauge steam locomotive of the **East Tennessee and Western North Carolina Railroad (ET&WNC)**, which ran train service from Johnson City TN to Boone NC from 1919 to 1940. Built in 1917 by the Baldwin Locomotive Works, Philadelphia. Const. No. 45069. Fueled by coal. Working wt. approx. 82.5 Tons. Arrangement 4-6-0.



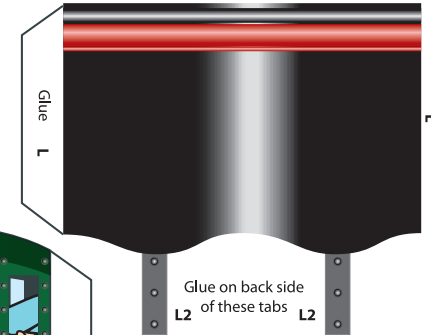
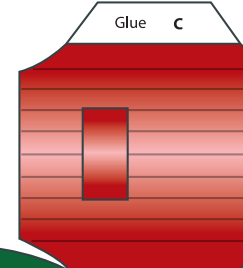

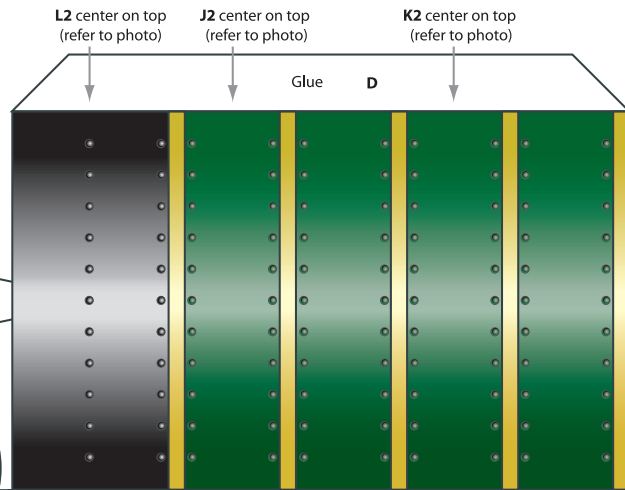

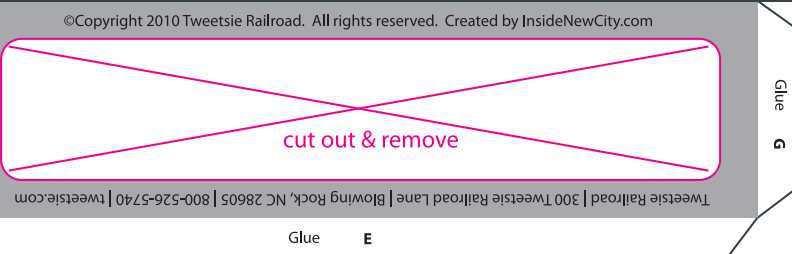
